NEED HELP?

Everyone finds themselves in need of help from time to time - we experience the loss of job, medical expenses, family transitions, floods, fires and more. These events often lead to challenging financial situations and we find ourselves a little short on funds, food, clothes and other basic necessities. When that happens, we are here to help...

WHAT WE OFFER

Food Pantry

Through our food pantry we are able to provide short-term help of non-perishable food items; things like canned fruits, vegetables, soups, pasta, baby food and more. The food we share is provided by donations from our church and community. We occasionally are also able to provide perishable items like frozen foods, milk, bread and other grocery items.

We also have a **Blessing Box** next to our parking lot which has been provided by one of our church members as an Eagle Scout Project. Members of our church and community put food items, toiletries, books and other items in the Blessing Box for those in our community who just need a little help getting through the week. Items in the Blessing Box are free to the public, we ask that you only take what you need and donate to the Box when you can.

Clothes Closet

Through the generous donations of our church and community we are able to meet clothing needs through our Clothes Closet. We have clothes and shoes for infants, children, youth and adults. We also are occasionally able to provide toiletries such as shampoo, lotion and other items. We periodically open our clothes closet to the community, but clothes are always available to those who find themselves in a crisis.

KARM Cards

Through a partnership with Knox Area Ministries thrift stores, we are able to provide gift cards to local KARM Stores. These cards can be used for clothes, shoes or household items.
